**Code of Conduct
For
Governor General's Youth Award (GGYA) Volunteers**

Purpose: To ensure that Governor General's Youth Award (**GGYA**; also referred to as **the Award**) volunteers are aware of and committed to the values and vision of the Award in conjunction with the Duke of Edinburgh's International Award.

Volunteers with active status in the GGYA Programme are subject to the following:

1. All Award volunteers must be 21 years or older.
2. Refrain from the use of inappropriate, obscene or abusive language.
3. Smoking (of any kind of substance) is prohibited.
4. Consumption of alcoholic beverages is not allowed at GGYA participant events or activities.
5. No fraternization and inappropriate relationships with participants.
6. A volunteer shall not display or engage in intimate contact or actions that are sexual in nature during GGYA events.
7. Volunteers are not allowed in areas designated for the opposite sex.
8. Volunteers must conduct tutoring, mentoring and coaching in open public view or in the presence of another adult volunteer.
9. All relevant GGYA fees must be recorded and paid into the National Award office. Volunteers must be given a receipt for all payments.
10. Volunteers must protect the name of the GGYA at all times.
11. Accept orientation and training as necessary in order to provide quality service.
12. Must complete on-line training modules outlined on the training guidelines.
